

Student Presentation Guidelines

Date/Time: Thursday, December 11, 2008 from 11:30 AM – 2:20 PM, L1116. **All registered students are expected to remain for all presentations.** This is out of respect to your fellow classmates and Prof. Di Lorenzo, in addition to grading (see below).

Length of Time: 12 minute talk + 2 minute question period (**enforced**). Students are **highly** encouraged to ask questions.

Media: All talks must be electronic, either using Powerpoint or PDF. You are responsible for making sure your talk is compatible and works with the computer in L1116.

Talks: All talks must be uploaded onto the server no later than **Thursday, December 11 @ 8 AM EST**. Use the upload site of the homeworks. Talks not uploaded by this time will be considered late and receive penalty points. The talks will be pre-loaded onto the computer in order to facilitate quicker transitions from speaker to speaker.

Order: The order of the talks will be pre-determined and set up to help accommodate different topics/continuity.

Grading: All students will receive a sheet upon which they will grade their fellow students' presentations. Of course, Prof. Di Lorenzo and I will also be grading, but your input will be influential.

Refreshments: Some refreshments will be served at the expense of Prof. Di Lorenzo.
